
Chapter 12.4: Mutations

Sometimes cells make mistakes when copying their own DNA

<u>Mutations</u>: changes in the genetic material

- gene mutations
- chromosomal mutations




<u>Point mutations</u>: Gene mutations with changes in only a few nucleotides bases

- <u>Substitutions</u>: when one base is changed to another
- Insertions:
 when a base
 is inserted
- <u>Deletions</u>: when a base is removed

Substitution

T G G C A G T G G T A G

Chromosomal mutations involve changes in the number or structure of chromosomes.
