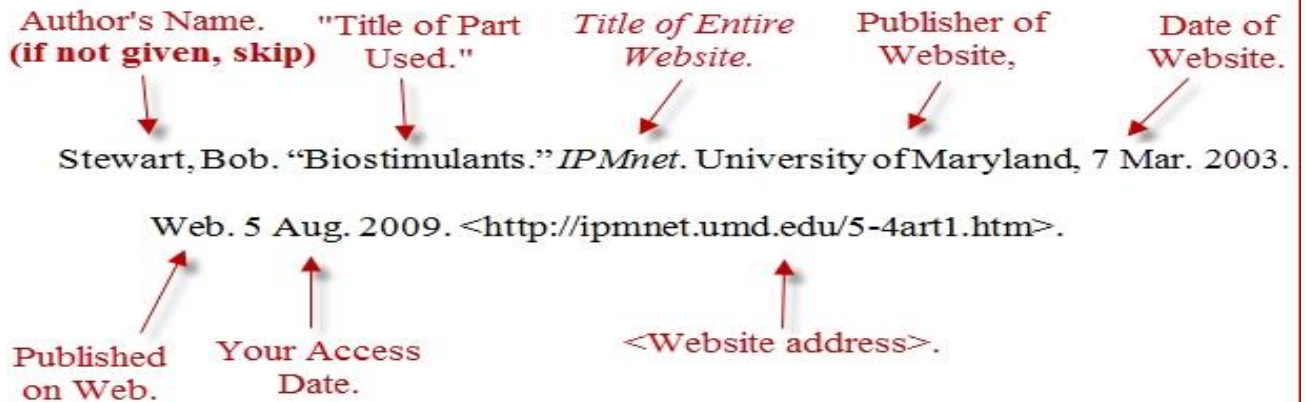


How to Cite Websites in MLA Format

Author (Last name, first name). Title of webpage (in italics). Website (who published the information), the year published. Date you accessed the site. URL <in brackets>.

If there is no author or date, you may simply exclude that information.



You must list all your sources in alphabetical order in the same font, size, and color on a single document. See example below:
